Overview

Participants are invited to submit original research abstracts aligned with the conference themes. The abstract should clearly present the purpose, methodology, results (or expected outcomes), and significance of the study. All submissions will undergo a review and selection process for advancement to the next phase.

Submission Deadline

- **Submission Period:** May 05 – May 30, 2026
- **Result Announcement:** June 06, 2026

Abstract Requirements

- **Length:** 250–300 words (strictly enforced)
- **Language:** Must be written in clear and concise English

Format Structure (Highly Recommended)

Your abstract should follow this standard structure:

1. **Title**
 - Clear, concise, and descriptive
 - Avoid abbreviations
2. **Background / Introduction**
 - Brief context and problem statement
3. **Objective**
 - Clearly state the purpose of the study
4. **Methodology**
 - Approach, tools, or techniques used
5. **Results / Expected Outcomes**
 - Key findings or anticipated results
6. **Conclusion / Significance**
 - Importance and impact of the study

Formatting Guidelines

- **Font:** Times New Roman / Arial
- **Font Size:** 11–12 pt
- **Line Spacing:** 1.15 – 1.5
- **Alignment:** Justified
- **File Format:** DOC/DOCX
- **File Name Format:**
ThemeName_UniversityName_AuthorName.docx

Theme Selection

- Each abstract must be submitted under one primary theme
- Ensure strong relevance to the selected theme
- Interdisciplinary topics are encouraged

Authorship Details

Include:

- Full Name(s) of author(s)
- University name
- Department
- Email address
- Phone number

One **presenting author** must be clearly identified

Important Rules

- Abstract must be original and unpublished
- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited
- AI-generated content without understanding is discouraged
- Multiple submissions are allowed, but must be distinct topics
- Incomplete submissions will be rejected

Evaluation Criteria

Abstracts will be reviewed based on:

- Originality & Innovation
- Relevance to Theme
- Clarity & Organization
- Scientific/Technical Quality
- Practical or Theoretical Impact

Selection Process

- Top abstracts will be shortlisted for Phase 2 (Poster Submission)
- Selected participants will be notified via email and website announcement

Submission Process

- Submit via official website form
- Upload your abstract file
- Vague methodology
- Poor grammar or formatting
- Irrelevant to selected theme
